For the purpose of the retreat, there is no need for the cabins to be near each other as we'll be meeting in a designated space for workshops and meetings. So please choose the cabin that fits the best within your budget.

#### Extra guests

You are welcome to bring along a guest who isn't attending the retreat. Please let our PHP know, as well as us.

#### What's included on the cruise

- Accommodation in a cabin for eight days and seven nights on board the Carnival Luminosa (ex-Brisbane)
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner at a restaurant or buffet designated as included in the cruise cost (visit the Carnival site for details )
- 24-hour food
- Onboard entertainment and most activities
- Access to gymnasium and pools (including a relaxing indoor-outdoor retreat just for adult guests.)

## **THINGS TO KNOW**

- All bookings must be paid for before you can submit your pages to be assessed to us. The last date for assessments submission is:
  - o March Cruise:25<sup>th</sup> February
  - o October Cruise: 24<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
- Our PHP will advise the deposit amount and when full payment is due as it will vary depending on price/closeness to the cruise departing time.
- You will need a valid passport with at least six months validity. Whilst the Writers at Sea PHP will check your passport and visa requirements, we encourage you to also ensure that your passport and visas are up-to-date.
- COVID Vaccinations please refer to the Carnival Site for all Vaccinations requirements for COVID.
- You will need to arrive at Brisbane Cruise terminal before 4.00 pm to board the ship.
   Boarding times will vary depending on Carnival and will be advised by our PHP prior to departure.
- On the last day, we will arrive in Brisbane at approximately 8:00 am. Debarkation times vary. You will be asked to choose a debarkation time a few days prior to arriving in Brisbane.
- Swimming towels are available on board and can be swapped for fresh ones during the hours of pool operation
- Internet is available for a fee. If you book an internet package, the cost will be billed directly to your room. Please note the WIFI can be slow and is best used for email or social media as it is not likely to work well for Netflix, etc. There is no general free WIFI hot spot on the ship. We advise you to switch your phone to aeroplane mode to avoid costly cruise ship costs of calls.
- We suggest the buffet breakfast for workshop days, as the dining room can be slow but the option is there if you choose to utilise it.
- On workshop days we recommend that your lunch is taken in a buffet restaurant or from other little cafés on that deck. So you can enjoy an hour or so of sunshine too!
- We have opted for early dining. A group meal is the perfect chance to have a break after a productive day so you can debrief and get to know your fellow writers better. But it also means that people can easily take in evening shows or spend more time

after dinner writing. Sometimes you might need to leave before the meal is completed.

- When booking flights from Brisbane on the last day, please ensure your flight leaves no earlier than 3 pm due to the possibility of the ship arriving late (it doesn't happen often).
- You will need to bring a working laptop and writing materials. (Don't forget your charging cord and an international USA plug adapter.)
- Please remember to take out travel insurance (that covers Covid and cancellations) when you book your cabin. At the time of writing Carnival will not allow cruisers to board the ship without travel insurance.

## **PORT DAYS**

You are welcome to explore the ports – as part of the retreats are for relaxation too, for the mind and body! Alli has travelled to the Pacific many times so she can give you the best advice for you to make the most of your shore visit without spending too much money.

You can view the excursions you can take with Carnival (not included in your retreat price) once you have a cruise number and are logged into the Carnival website.

Please note that you don't have to get off the ship – this is your choice. You can always get off the ship and just do your own 'exploring', which doesn't cost you anything.
